STUDENTS' COUNCIL ACTIVITIES 2017 -2018

- In order to encourage the reading habit among the students, *Vaasagar Vattam* has been formed on behalf of the Students' Council. Four meetings have been convened in this regard on 25.06.2017, 09.10.2017, 06.11.2017 and 03.01.2018.
- A Cancer Awareness Programme was conducted on behalf of the Students' Council on 10.01.2018, Dr. V. Arumugam, Oncologist and Dr. Abdul Rahman, Psychiatrist delivered lectures on *Cancer Awareness*.
- In collaboration with the Department of Tamil the Students' Council organized a Diwali Debate with the title "Uravugalal Namaku Peruguvathu Santhoshangala Sangadangala" on 03.10.2017. Mr. Sundara Avudaiyappan, All India Radio was the Moderator for the Debate. As a part of Pongal Celebrations, a debate was organized

on 09.01.2018 with the title "Valvin Nimidangal Karumbai Inikindrana – Kasappai Irukindrana" Mr. Sundara Avudaiyappan, All India Radio was the Moderator.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL ACTIVITIES 2018 -2019

- The students' Council has collected a sum of Rs. 60,000/- from the students and staff of Sadakathullah Appa College towards the Medical Aid of S. Abdul Rahman, S/o. S. Seyad Ali, a 4-year-old boy who had blood cancer.
- The Students' Council has collected a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- from the students and Staff of Sadakathullah Appa College towards the Medical Aid of the college student Sowmesh of I B.A. English who also had blood cancer.
- A meeting between the College Management Committee and the class representatives was held on 28.08.2018. The Honourable Secretary and Correspondent, Alhaj. T.E.S. Fathu Rabbani, Executive Committee Members Alhaj. K.A. Meeran Mohideen, Alhaj. M.K.M. Mohamed Nazar and Janab. Er. L.K.M.A. Muhammad Nawab Hussain, Principal Dr. M. Mohamed Sathik, Director of Unaided COURSES Dr. A. Abdul Kader and the Students' Council Advisor Dr. A. Hamil were present.
- The Students' Council has collected a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- from the students and staff of Sadakathullah Appa College towards the Medical Aid of the College Student Mohamed Faizal of II B.Com. (Unaided) who met with an accident.
- The Students' Council collected relief materials worth Rs. 10,00,000/- from the students, staff and public towards offering a helping hand to the neighbouring state Kerala when it was devastated by floods.
- The Department of Tamil and the Students' Council jointly organized Pongal Tamil Debate on 08.01.2019 with the title *Tamil Culture – Respected or Refused*. Thiru. Putheneri Ko Chellapa was the judge.
- The Students' Council has celebrated the International Women's Day on 08.03.2019. Mrs. Kumutha Sithiraputhiran, All India Radio, Tirunelveli, was the Chief Guest.

- Every year, the Students' Council publishes collection of poems written by the students themselves. This year the title of the poetry collection to be released is *Kaalanathi.*
- The student volunteers of Sadakathullah Appa College collected and distributed relief materials worth Rs. 3,00,000/- to the flood affected areas during the cyclone Gaja. A team of students went to the areas and distributed the relief materials such as candles, biscuits, food items, rice, grocery, bed sheets, dresses and other items. It is remarkable to note that, at times of such natural disasters every year the managing committee members, teachers, non-teaching staff and students rise up to the occasion and contribute profusely to the devastated people.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL ACTIVITIES 2019 -2020

- In co-ordination with the SeethakkathiTamil Peravai, Students' Council of the College has conducted a programme on 06-08-2019, Sahithya Awardees S. Dharman, and Colachel Yousuf were the invited speakers.
- On 07.01.2020, Pongal Debate was jointly organized by the Students' Council and Department of Tamil, Dr. Abdul Rahim, Associate Professor of Tamil, Dr. Zakir Hussain College, Ilayankudi was the Judge. On 21.02.2020 International Tamil Language Day was celebrated in the College in co-ordination with the Students' Council with Mr. V. Senthil Nayagan as a resource person. In the college a Selfdevelopment Centre was inaugurated in the name of *AGAM* in co-ordination with the Students' Council which was inaugurated by Mr. William Dharmaraja on 18.08.2019.
- Through AGAM a special lecture was conducted in co-ordination with the Students' Council on 25.09.2019. In this meeting C. Saravanan, Assistant Commissioner of Police was invited and he spoke on the topic "Women Social Welfare". A special lecture was organized by AGAM on 16.12.2019 on the topic Women and Safety. Mr. C. Yuvaraj, Head, Department of Psychology, was the Chief Guest. Students' Council of the college celebrated International Women's Day on 09.03.2020; Mrs. Sumathy was the Chief Guest.

The philanthropic activities of the Students' Council are highly appreciable. The Students' Council of the College has three Social Welfare Schemes which includes Students' Self-Help Scheme (SSHS), 'Students' Help in First Aid' (SHIFA) and *Manitham*. For these schemes students voluntarily contribute funds and these funds are distributed to the needy. Through the SSHS a sum of Rs. 49,260 was collected from the students and a sum of Rs. 2,000 each was distributed to 22 economically weaker students from different classes in order to meet their academic expenses. Under the SHIFA, Rs. 1,45,640/- has been collected and out of this fund Rs. 33,900/- was distributed to a child affected by cancer and similarly Rs. 76,715/- was distributed to another cancer patient.
