COLLEGE HISTORY

Ever since the British period, the twin towns of Tirunelveli and Palayamkottai, intersected by the perennial Tamiraparani river, have been great centres of learning. The Tirunelveli district has a sizable Muslim population which felt the need for an institution of higher education. Due to the dedicated and sincere efforts of the Muslim elite, a college of arts and sciences, named after the noted Arabic Scholar Sadakathullah Appa, was started in 1971.

The foundation stone was laid by Janab Syed Abdul Wahab Buhari Sahib. M.A.L.T., Rector, Madrasa Jamalia, Madras on 5.02.1971 (8th Dhul - Haj 1390). The College was inaugurated by Alhaj. M. Mohammed Ismail Sahib. (President Indian Union Muslim League) on 4.08.1971 in the presence of former Educational Minister Honourable V.R. Neduncheliyan and Dr. Mu. Varadarasanar, former Vice - Chancellor of Madurai Kamaraj University.

The college is located on a 40 acre sprawling campus. It was first affiliated to the Madurai Kamaraj University for twenty years. With the birth of the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in 1990, the college was affiliated to it. It is run by the SADAKATHULLAH APPA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY.

Since 1971, the college has been witnessing an exponential growth in terms of infrastructure, courses, faculty strength and students strength. The milstones of the college are listed below:

- ★ ISO 9001:2015 Re-Certification in 17th June 2021. The college offers Undergraduate (U.G.) programmes in Tamil, Arabic, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Computer

Arabic, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology, Microbiology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Commerce, Business Administration, Psychology, Economics and B.Lib.I.Sc. The college offers Postgraduate (P.G.) programmes in English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science, Microbiology, Molecular Modeling & Drug Design, Commerce and Nutrition and Dietetics. M.Phil programmes are offered by the Departments of English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science and Commerce and Ph.D. programmes are offered by the Departements of English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Microbiology, Computer Science and Commerce. Apart from this the college has 15 certificate courses and 1 diploma course. Typewriting Course, Tailoring Course, Remedial Course in Mathematics and Bridge Course in English are the other courses offfered to the students to equip themselves with extra skills needed for placements.

Under Sadakath Academy, Short-Term Career-Oriented courses such as Chartered Accountancy (CPT and Intermediate), Cost and Management Accountant (Foundation Course and Intermediate) and Company Secretary (Foundation Course and Intermediate) are being offered since the academic year 2016-2017. Coaching classes for SET, NET and Competitive Examinations are also conducted.

Every year the Placement Cell conducts on and off campus drives and supports students in terms of recruitments.

105 endowments amounting to Rs.40,00,000/- have been sponsored by well-wishers and retired staff. In addition, there are 69 patrons, who have donated a sum of Rs.63,50,000/- which is spent on scholarships, prizes and special lectures.

The Islamic Study Circle too gives scholarships from the Zakat Fund collected from the staff. The Alumni-Association of our college has been a source of support to the growth of the college.

The college runs **Sadakath - A Research Bulletin,** a multidisciplinary research journal, indexed in Google Scholar (ISSN:2347-7644).

Sadakathullah Appa College is the Local centre for NPTEL (National Programme on Technology - Enhanced Learning).

The college has introduced many innovative schemes : 'Earn While You Learn' - economically under-privileged students being favoured with part-time jobs at various offices of the college, 'Students' Self-Help Scheme' (SSHS), 'Students Help in First Aid' (SHIFA) and 'Manitham' - a humanitarian and public spirited movement to provide food and shelter for the abandoned and the mentally-deranged people in and around Tirunelveli.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GOOD MANNERS AND BEHAVIOURS :

- ★ Every student should conform to the rules and regulations relating to attendance, library, college fees, examinations, etc., Hostel residents must obey the hostel regulations.
- ★ Students are forbidden to smoke on the college premises, to write or make any marks on the walls or to throw paper or ink on the floor of the classrooms or the verandas.
- ★ Students are not allowed to stand or walk along the verandas of the college during class hours.
- ★ Strict silence must be observed during class hours in the classrooms.
- ★ Students are expected to be courteous to all, especially, to their Professors and Elders.
- ★ When a faculty or any other member of the staff enters a class room, the students must stand and should not remain seated until the staff invites them to do so or he himself takes the seat. They should likewise stand up when the staff leaves the class room.
- ★ No student should leave the classroom during lecture hours without permission of the faculty. Similarly, no student can call out any student from the class without permission from the faculty.

- ★ Any difference that may arise among the students and staff should be resolved by peaceful methods, and with a spirit of give and take. Therefore students should not address any authority in a collective body. Such an action is subversive to good order. Requests, petitions, appeals and complaints of any kind must be made in the first place to the Head of the Department concerned and never directly to higher authorities.
- College property and furniture should be handled with care and anyone who damages them will be held liable to pay for the damage caused. Stealing of college property or belongings of others constitutes a serious offence and therefore immediate action will be taken. Lights and fans in the classroom must be switched off when there is no lecture in the class.
- ★ Science students will not be permitted to take away any broken apparatus from the laboratory.
- ★ Two-wheelers should be parked in the sheds and not anywhere else on campus.
- ★ Students are expected to regularly go through the notices put up on the notice board. Ignorance of any notice thus displayed will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with directions contained in it.

DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

(Cfr. Tamilnadu Educational Rules (1973) Nos. 93-98)

- Students are forbidden to organise or attend any meetings on the college premises, or collect money for any purpose without explicit permission from the Principal.
- No student who has been convicted of any offence in a criminal court will be allowed to continue his studies in the college.
- Students should abstain themselves from active participation in party or communal politics.
- Students who indulge in political propaganda or who organise fellow students into political factions on the premises of the college or hostels, or who otherwise engage themselves in party or politics are liable to be expelled from the college and hostels.
- Under the educational rules of the Tamilnadu Government (1978) the Principal has full power to inflict the following punishments, if any student is guilty of rudeness of behaviour and gross breach of rules: fine, loss of term certificate, suspension and expulsion from the college.

- Students should not indulge in any activity leading to the disruption of peace and discipline and dislocation of normal work on the college and hostel permises. Those who are guilty of viloation of this will be severely punished.
- Ragging of any kind is strictly forbidden. Anyone who is guilty of ragging will be summarily and severely punished.
- Students who are guilty of (i) rude language towards the staff of the college or hostels (ii) assault or attempt to assault the staff or fellow students of the college or hostels will be expelled from the institution.
- Students who bring their vehicles to college should produce photocopies of their driving license, vehicle Insurance and RC Book to the College. The same should be kept by those students always for verification by the college authorities.
- Students should not bring or use mobile phones on campus. If found possessing mobile phone on campus, it will be seized and would not be returned back. Also the defaulters will be severely dealt with by the authorities.

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

LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Perfect silence should be maintained in the library.
- 2. All days are working days except Sunday and Government holidays.
- 3. The Library works from 8.00 a.m to 6.30 p.m [Without any Break]
- 4. The Library will be open on Saturdays, Examination days and Semester holidays from 10.00 a.m to 4.00 p.m.
- 5. The personal belongings of the students (bags, books, notebooks, etc.) should not be brought inside the library.
- 6. Library users should not move the chairs.
- 7. Cellular phones and audio instruments are strictly prohibited in the library premises.
- 8. Enter your name and signature in the Gate Register before entering the library.
- 9. Students will not be permitted to enter the library without ID cards.
- 10. Two Books will be issued for UG students, 4 Books for PG Students, M.Phil and Ph.D Scholars
- 11. Teaching faculty can borrow five books. However the duration of lending should not exceed one semester.
- 12. Non-Teaching staff can borrow three books only. However the duration of lending should not exceed one semester.
- 13. For students, the books are lent for 14 days. Books should be compulsorily returned on the due date. In case, if the due date falls on a holiday the books should be returned on the next working day.

- 14. Books shall be renewed once on request while being returned. A second renewal shall be made at the discretion of the Librarian.
- 15. An overdue charge of 50 paise will be collected per day for not returning the book on the due date.
- 16. Loss of library books should be immediately reported to the Librarian.
- 17. In case if the borrower loses or damages the library book(s) he / she has to replace the book(s) or pay triple the cost of the book(s).
- Journals, Magazines, Thesis, Project Reports, Reference Books, CD / DVD's and Newspapers are for reference only.
- 19. Any kind of marking, underlining or clipping of the books is completely forbidden.
- 20. No Due Certificate must be got from the Librarian while relieving from the college.
- 21. Library books be used with utmost care and be returned without any damage. Damaged book(s) shall not be accepted and they have to be replaced by the borrower.
- 22. Exchange of library books among staff members or students should be avoided.
- 23. The Librarian may recall any book from any member at any time and the member should abide by it immediately.
- 24. The library accepts donation of useful manuscripts, books and journals etc., for the use by staff and students.
- 25. If any user is found to violate the rules, the College will take severe action on him/ her.

The college became co-educational in the academic year 1996-'97. Consequently a hostel for women became imperative.

Ladies Hostel-I was constructed with financial assistance from Maulana Abulkalam Azad Educational Foundation, New Delhi. The growing number of girl students every year necessitated the establishment of another hostel. Eventually, Ladies Hostel-II was constructed with financial aid from the UGC.

Female students from the aided stream are accomodated in Ladies Hostel - II and those from the unaided stream in Ladies Hostel - I.

AUTONOMY

Sadakathullah Appa College was conferred with autonomous status by the UGC and Manonmaniam Sundaranar University on 03.01.2007. Eventhough the college is affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, getting autonomous status for an institution is considered a mark of high esteem, prestige and honour.

It elevates the institution to stand high in the academic arena. It gives not only freedom to the institution to design curriculum to suit students' needs but also helps the institution to produce patriotic citizens whose primary efforts would be towards acquiring knowledge and skills of Science and Technology, Humanities and Literature.

The Autonomy Programme will ensure innovative teaching methods, freedom to teachers to design the curriculum, assessment and evaluation. The students, no doubt, will reap the benefit finally.

The financial assistance given by the University Grants Commission is a boon to an autonomous institution. The main objective of an autonomous institution is to offer quality education.

Sadakathullah Appa College, with the bounteous Grace of Almighty Allah, successfully reviewed the first extension of the Autonomous status in 2012-13. Subsequently in 2018-19, the Autonomy Review Committee nominated by the University Grants Commission visited the college for the second Review of the Autonomous status and the Extension of the Autonomous status has been conferred from 2018-19 to 2022 - 23.

CHOICE-BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) is introduced in all Arts and Science colleges in Tamilnadu from the academic year 2008 - 2009. It gives opportunity for students to choose, join and study simultaneously (along with their own respective programme) a programme from other disciplines. The CBCS facilitates the students to study more useful papers as Skill-Based Electives and Non-Major Electives. Under the CBCS Pattern many number of skillbased, career-oriented and interdepartmental courses are offered and credits are awarded.

Extra Credit Courses (ECC), offered outside the regular class hours, add to the credits. The minimum credits to be secured in the UG degree level is 140 and the PG degree is 90. The CBCS System, no doubt, will mould the students fit to be employed at the technological world.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS UNDER CBCS

➤ The medium of instruction in all the UG and PG programmes is English and students shall write the CIA and the semester examinations in English. Three tests for 1 hr duration will be conducted for CIA and the average of best 2 tests will be taken. The portion for each test can be 1.5 units of the unitized syllabus.

> Two assignments for undergraduate programmes and one assignment and one seminar for postgraduate programmes are compulsory.

> Two practical examinations will be conducted for CIA at the end of the semester and the average will be taken.

End Semester Examination (ESE)

All those students who have put in the required number of days of attendance are eligible to appear for the ESE irrespective of whether they have passed in the CIA or not. They have to pay the examination fees for all the current courses and the arrear courses, if any, and submit the application form before the due date, specified for the purpose. For any reason the dates will not be extended. Hall tickets will be issued only for those who have paid the fees. The question papers for the ESE for all theory courses of the UG and PG programmes will be set for 75 marks

Question Pattern for End Semester Examinations (Practical)

Question paper pattern is designed by the respective departments.

GRIEVANCES REGARDING EXAMINATIONS

An anomaly in a question paper (such as question being out of syllabus, wrong or insufficient data in problems etc.) of the Semester Examinations should be brought to the notice of the Controller of Examinations in writing through the HOD concerned within 48 hours of the conduct of the examinations.

This facilitates the Controller of Examinations to examine the representation and take suitable remedial action. A student is deemed to have taken the examination, the moment he / she receives the question paper, even if it contains an anomaly.

Students shall refer the issues concerning examinations (viz. anomalies in the question paper, special supplementary examinations) to the Controller of Examinations in writing. The Controller of Examinations refers to the Examinations Grievances Redressal Committee for further steps.

MALPRACTICE IN CIA / SEMESTER EXAM

If a student is found copying from some manuscript or printed sheet or any other incriminating material, or is found possessing any such material, he / she will be stopped from writing the examination and asked to produce a statement in writing about his / her case, and leave the hall.

The invigilator concerned / squad will seize the incriminating material, confiscate the Hall Ticket, Identity Card and answer script of the student, and provide a statement of his own along with that of the student to the Chief Controller of Examinations who will in turn forward it to the Controller of Examinations with his endorsement.

SYLLABUS

A student failing in a paper in the Semester Examination is permitted to write that examination under the same syllabus. In the event of a change in the structure of course pattern or the syllabus, the HOD concerned works out a subject equivalence duly approved by the Academic Deans and authorized by the Academic Council.

A student who registers for any UG and PG Degree Programme will have to complete the programme within five years and four years respectively. Otherwise, the student has to re-register.

SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

In general, all theory question papers will be set by External Examiners. Single Valuation is followed for Undergraduate and Career-Oriented Programmes and double valuation for Postgraduate Programmes.

The students having arrear papers are permitted to write their arrear along with the regular papers. A maximum of 4 arrear papers may be written in the semester examination. However, final year students can write all the arrear papers in the last semester along with the regular papers.

A student must have done a minimum of 75% of the list of practicals arranged by the class teacher and should submit the record note-book. The practical examination will be conducted by one external and one internal examiners. The rules governing theory examinations will apply for absentees, and failed candidates, who wish to take the practical examinations again The Student may be permitted to appear for the subsequent papers conditionally. Later, the student will be asked to appear before the Examination Discipline Committee to decide the sanctions against them for having indulged in malpractice. The sanction will vary according to the gravity of the fault, ie, from being debarred from one paper or all the papers of one semester, to being debarred from two or three subsequent semesters, if necessary, as per the malpractice policy followed in the college.

The candidates who fail to appear before the Examination Discipline Committee will be fined Rs. 300/- and in addition they will be suspended from the college until they bring their parents.

Students who involve in malpractices in CIA Tests / Semester examinations will be fined Rs. 200/-. The examinations written during that cycle will be cancelled.

Post - examination discovery of malpractices will be referred to the Controller of Examinations by the Examiner. The Controller will refer the matter to the Examination Discipline Committee for a decision. The rules prevailing in M.S. University regarding malpractice and those framed by our Academic Council will serve as guidelines.

AWARDS COMMITTEE

After the valuation, the Examination Discipline Committee is convened to decide the sanctions against those who indulged in malpractice. Then the results are scrutinized by the Awards Committee and then it is published on the College Website.

REVALUATION AND RETOTALLING

The UG, PG and M.Phil., students can apply for revaluation of only regular/arrear theory paper in the Semester Examination in the prescribed form available at the Office of the Controller of Examinations within five days from the date of publication of the result.

Upon revaluation, the highest mark awarded is taken and the change is made in the Mark Statement accordingly. Photocopy of the answerscripts can also be obtained after paying the prescribed fee.

There is no provision for revaluation or retotalling of practical papers and project reports at the UG, PG and M.Phil., levels. No part of the revaluation / retotalling fee is refunded under any circumstances.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS

Supplementary Examinations will be held only for final year regular students (not for Private Students). This is applicable for those students who have arrears in not more than 2 theory papers taking into account all the semesters. The candidate should apply in the prescribed form within three days from the date of publication of the revaluation results.

Students, who are absent or failed in the regular final semester examination, are eligible to write a maximum of 2 theory papers in the supplementary examinations.

The students, who have arrears in the previous semesters (UG-I, II, III, IV, V, PG - I, II, III, M.Phil. - I) should have appeared and got fail marks in the final semester to get eligibility to write the supplementary examinations.


Totally a maximum of only 2 (two) theory papers can be written in the supplementary examination. There is no supplementary examination for practicals.

MARK STATEMENTS

Mark Statements are distributed to students in their departments on the day announced by the Controller of Examinations. The students must bring their parents to receive the statement of marks. For students who have completed the programme successfully, a consolidated mark statement in the prescribed format will be issued. A student can apply for a duplicate mark statement / or a consolidated mark statement by paying the prescribed fee. This is carried out after the usual process of police verification, submission of F.I.R. copy etc.,
